In August, Marion McCall had us in fits of laughter as she recalled some of her exploits and experiences in the air at the time her husband, David, was Bishop of Willochra.




At our luncheon at The Naval Military and Air Force Club, the speaker will be Emily Kelly, State Manager of Musica Viva. Further details to follow.
